Directions To Backwoods:

From AL Highway 9: Turn East onto County Rd 58, approx. 7 miles north of Lineville, AL or 3.5 miles south of Delta, AL. Go approx. 6 miles straight. (A road sign will indicate that County Rd 58 turns a hard right. Do not turn, but continue going straight. This road becomes County Rd. 82 at the Randolph County Line.) Turn right at BCC sign. Follow camp signs approx. 2 miles to campground.

From AL Highway 431: Turn West on County Road 82, approx. 19 miles south of I - 20 or 11 miles North of Wedowee, AL. Go approximately 5 miles and turn left at BCC sign. Follow camp signs to campground.

Backwoods Christian Camp Rules & Policies

- KINDNESS**
- Boy - Girl relationships are restricted to holding of hands only.
- Dress Code:**
 - Shoes must be worn at all times.
 - T-shirts and jeans are appropriate.
 - Positively no shorts, halter tops, or exposed midriffs. No tank-tops see-through clothing or anything else that would be considered lascivious or immodest.
 - Clothing is to be worn to and from the shower area.
 - All clothing must cover the knee cap.
- Moral Character**
 - Absolutely no tobacco, alcohol, or drugs other than prescription drugs which are to be given to the nurse upon arrival.
 - Language and behavior should be Christ-like.
 - No knives or firearms are allowed at BCC. These items will be taken and kept until parents can personally retrieve them.
- No ipods, mp3 players, cell phones, CD players, portable electronic games, or any other form of electronic entertainment is permitted on camp grounds.
- Hazing and care of private property**
 - No camper will be permitted to commit any act toward another camper which will endanger the usefulness of his private property and / or his personal safety.
 - This camp has been donated for camper use. Therefore, all food is to be fed to campers and all trash is to be fed to the trash cans. We insist that campgrounds be left clean at the end of each session and motivate each camper to do their part.
- Any camper is subject to the authority of any counselor at any time or any place. Primarily, a camper is responsible to his/her counselor.
- Every camper is to be present for all scheduled activities unless otherwise excused by camp director or nurse.
- The camper must report to his/her counselor before going to the nurse or director, except in an emergency.
- Only sickness will excuse one from missing any spiritual activity.
- Campers must stay within the camp boundaries.
- Campers must abide by curfew rules.

BCC Dress Code
